Fellowships for Primary-Care Nurses

A limited number of fellowships for 1978 are available to nurses wishing to pursue a career in academic primary care and family medicine. Each fellowship program is tailored to individual needs but the emphasis is on development of investigative and teaching skills.

ELIGIBILITY

Fellowships are awarded to two categories of primary care nurse:

1. Those having recently completed a Master's program (Career Development Fellows)
2. University faculty nurses wishing to take a sabbatical (Sabbatical Fellows)

Candidates must give evidence of a bilateral teaching agreement with a university department to run at least 2 years after completion of the Fellowship program.

Preference will be given to candidates obtaining financial support from their home institutions to match support from Fellowship sources.

For Career Development Fellows, 2 years

For Sabbatical Fellows, 1 year

STIPENDS (per annum)

For Career Development Fellows, to \$10,000

For Sabbatical Fellows, to \$8,000

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING
